It is requested that the information herein presented be given formal consideration by the Board of County Commissioners at its regular meeting of September 21, 2021.

**DESCRIPTION AND CONDITIONS**

This agenda item is to consider the appointment of an applicant to fill the position of Board of County Commissioners representative on the MPO Bicycle Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BAC). The vacancy has been advertised on the County's website and on Channel 27 in excess of 30 days. The following are the names of qualified applicants for this position, whose résumés are available for review in the Commissioners' Front Office area:

- **Angela Speck**
- **Solana Morris**

Both applicants are active in the local bicycling community. Angela Speck submitted an application to be the BCC representative to the Bicycle Pedestrian Advisory Committee (BAC). Solana Morris applied to be her alternate and would attend in her absence. The BAC typically meets once each quarter.

**RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends that the Board review the résumés and applications of Angela Speck and Solana Morris and appoint Angela Speck as the Board of County Commissioners representative to the MPO Bicycle Pedestrian Advisory Committee and Solana Morris as the alternate.
