PROPOSED COMMISSIONER DISTRICT BOUNDARIES

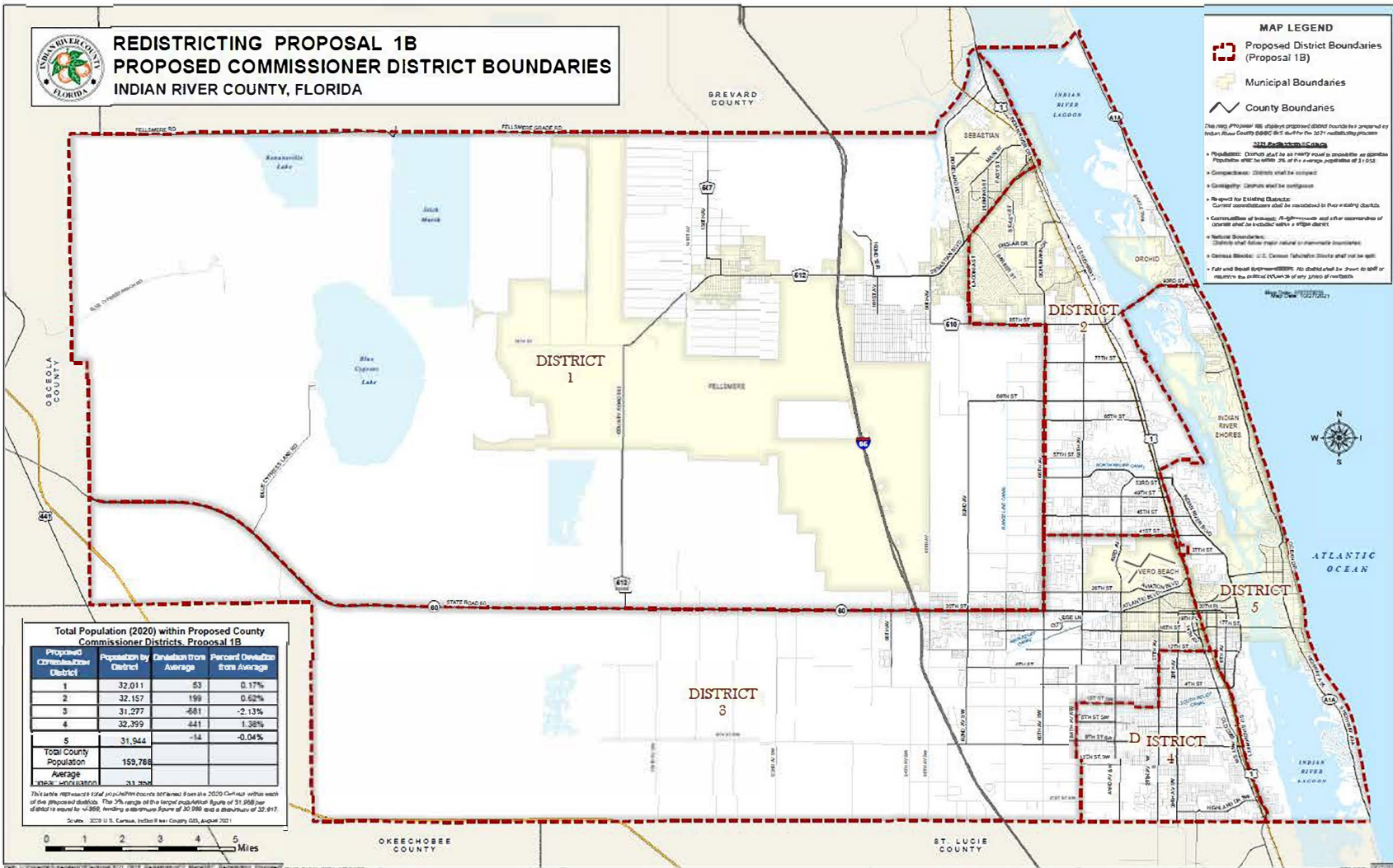

2020 Population Totals

- Population: Districts must be as nearly equal in population as possible. Population shall be within 2% of the average population of 32,017.
- Compactness: Districts shall be compact.
- Contiguity: Districts shall be contiguous.
- Respect for Existing Districts: Current representations shall be maintained in their existing districts.
- Communities of Interest: A neighborhood and other communities of interest shall be included within a single district.
- Natural Boundaries: Districts shall follow major natural or man-made boundaries.
- Census Blocks: U.S. Census Tracts/Blocks shall not be split.
- Fair and Equal Representation: No district shall be drawn to split or maintain the political power of any group of voters.
