**SUBJECT:** Public Hearing for Amendment to Section 312.11 (Performance Security) of Chapter 312 (Rights-of-Way) of the Indian River Code of Ordinances.

---

On March 15, 2022, the Indian River County Board of County Commissioners (“Board”) heard a proposal from Staff concerning a proposed change to Section 312.11 (Performance Security) of Chapter 312 (Rights-of-Way) of the Indian River Code of Ordinances (the “Code”). The proposed change would allow for the use of letters of credit as security for work in the County right-of-way. By a vote of 5 - 0, the Board directed staff to advertise and schedule a public hearing on the proposed draft ordinance.

The County Attorney’s Office has advertised the public hearing. The County Attorney’s Office recommends that the Board, after conducting the public hearing and taking any public input, approve the draft ordinance.

**FUNDING.**

The only impact to County funds for this item is the cost of \$126.54 to advertise for the public hearing and is being paid from Account No. 00110214-034910 (General Fund/County Attorney/Legal Ads).

**RECOMMENDATION.**

The County Attorney’s Office recommends that the Board, after conducting the public hearing and taking any public input, approve the draft ordinance.
