**DESCRIPTIONS AND CONDITIONS**

On November 6, 2018, the Board of County Commissioners approved and executed a project grant agreement with the Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND) for Oyster Bar Marsh Trail Public Use Improvements in its 2018-19 grant cycle. This grant provides \$120,000 in cost-share funds toward the public use improvements at the conservation area which are substantially complete, but not approved for final payment.

On July 1, 2020, staff requested an extension due to project delays caused by COVID-19 and subsequent, but unavoidable project delays. FIND has provided a Project Agreement Amendment to extend the grant completion period through September 30, 2022. Staff anticipates that the project will be completed by or before this date.

**FUNDING**

This is a no-cost amendment and no additional funds are necessary beyond what has been previously approved by the Board of County Commissioners.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends the Board accept the Project Agreement Amendment for #IR-18-68 Oyster Bar Marsh Trail and authorize the Chairman to execute the Amendment after review and approval by the County Attorney.
