In 1971, our founder J. Seward Johnson Sr. of the Johnson & Johnson family, in collaboration with famed inventor Edwin A. Link, had a vision to create an institute to **preserve the environment through a scientific understanding of the ocean**, and, 50 years later, that is how we continue to view our research.
