SUBJECT: First Extensions and Amendments to Disaster Debris Management Services

Agreements

BACKGROUND:

On April 21, 2020, the Board awarded RFP 2020025 for Disaster Debris Management Services as may be needed to respond to catastrophic events, such as tropical storms, hurricanes or tornadoes, to Ceres Environmental Services, Inc. (primary), and CrowderGulf Joint Venture, Inc. (secondary). The term of the award was 24 months, with two additional 24-month terms available. Both contractors have agreed to execute the first extensions, which will be effective from April 21, 2022 through April 20, 2024.

Changes made effective to Florida Statute and the Code of Federal Regulations during the initial term of the agreement require the incorporation of additional clauses to the agreements.

FUNDING:

Expenses incurred for work under these agreements are anticipated to be funded through FEMA's reimbursement of CAT A debris expenses.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends the Board approve the Sample Extension and Amendment and authorize the Chairman to sign it after the County Attorney has approved it as to form and legal sufficiency.
