SUBJECT: Request of Ownership Change from Falck Southeast II, Corp d/b/a American Ambulance Service for Present Class “E” and Class “B” Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity

It is respectfully requested that the information contained herein be given formal consideration by the Board of County Commissioners at the next scheduled meeting.

Background:

On March 10, 2020, the Board approved a Class “E” and Class “B” Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide wheelchair/Stretcher and Interfacility Ambulance Transportation Services for Falck Southeast II, Corp d/b/a American Ambulance Service. On November 11, 2020 an application was submitted for an ownership change from Falck Southeast II, Corp d/b/a American Ambulance Service to RG Ambulance Service, Inc. All other information and requirements that were provided during the initial application process remained the same.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends the Board of County Commissioners approve the change of ownership and issue a new Class “E” and Class “B” COPCN certificate to reflect the ownership change.
