The Supervisor of Elections office collects fees for candidate and initiative petition verification and preparation of data lists. I am respectfully requesting to have the revenue received from petition verification fees and data list preparation be rolled back into the Supervisor of Elections FY2021/2022 budget.

The Supervisor of Elections office verified 34,897 petitions and fulfilled 58 data lists during FY2021 – 2022. I have enclosed the receipts for providing these services totaling \$6,243.35.

Three ballot-on-demand ballot printers malfunctioned during early voting for the August 23 Primary Election. Due to the age of the printers, replacement parts are no longer available. These funds will allow our office to purchase new printers.
