BACKGROUND:

The equipment on the attached list has been determined excess to the needs of Indian River County and requires disposal in accordance with Florida Statutes and Finance Policies. As previously authorized by the Board, the items will be sold by online auction and funds received from the sale of these items will be returned to the appropriate accounts.

DISCUSSION:

Asset 23933, a 2007 GMC Canyon Pickup (Fleet 198) was declared surplus by the Board on December 14, 2021, but has been requested to be reactivated and transferred to the Facilities Management Division, as ordering windows for new vehicles have been extremely short, with very long lead times.

The 911 Enhanced Digital Access Communication System ("EDACS") will be replaced in the coming months, and the department would like to request the Board's approval for the replacement contractor, Communications International, to dispose of them on the County's behalf:
