AN ORDINANCE OF INDIAN RIVER COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTIONS 304.02 (AUTHORITY AND PURPOSE), 304.02 (DEFINITIONS), 304.07 (SAME-INVESTIGATION; STAFF RECOMMENDATION), 304.08 (CONTENTS OF CERTIFICATE), 304.09 (INSPECTIONS), 304.11 (RENEWAL), 304.12 (REVOCATION, ALTERATION OR SUSPENSION) OF PART I (LIFE SUPPORT SERVICES) OF CHAPTER 304 (LIFE SUPPORT AND WHEELCHAIR SERVICES) OF CHAPTER 304 (LIFE SUPPORT AND WHEELCHAIR SERVICES) IN ORDER TO UPDATE TERMS AND ELIMINATE THE REGULATION OF WHEELCHAIR VEHICLE SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT AND SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
