HONORING THE MOONSHOT COMMUNITY AND THEIR CONTRIBUTION TO LITERACY

Whereas, literacy is the cornerstone of individual success and community prosperity, and we aspire to contribute to making Indian River County a national leader in literacy; and

Whereas, March is National Reading Month, providing an opportunity to emphasize the importance of literacy for all ages.
