

# PROCLAMATION

## DESIGNATING THE WEEK OF JULY 19, 2020 THROUGH JULY 25, 2020, AS TREASURE COAST WATERWAY CLEANUP WEEK

**WHEREAS**, on Saturday, July 25, 2020, the Marine Industries Association of the Treasure Coast in conjunction with the Florida Inland Navigation District will conduct the 13<sup>th</sup> Annual Treasure Coast Waterway Cleanup; and

**WHEREAS**, this event will attract approximately 1,000 volunteers who will participate in cleaning up the waterways of Indian River, Martin and St. Lucie Counties; and

**WHEREAS**, thirty-one designated sites throughout the three counties will serve as registration and disposal sites for the volunteers to work out of; and

**WHEREAS**, numerous waterfront homeowners' associations have been recruited to clean up their own waterfronts; and

**WHEREAS**, since the beginning, over 87.2 tons of trash has been collected from approximately 125 miles of waterways with an expectation of a significantly larger amount to be collected this year with an increased volunteer effort.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, INDIAN RIVER COUNTY, FLORIDA** that the week of July 19, 2020, through July 25, 2020, be designated as **TREASURE COAST WATERWAY CLEANUP WEEK** in Indian River County, and all citizens are encouraged to use this occasion to foster appreciation for the Treasure Coast Waterways and assist in the cleanup efforts.
