BACKGROUND

In order to comply with the State Division of Library Information Services State Aid Grant Application, the Indian River County Library System must have a Commission Approved Long Range Plan on file at the State. The Plan runs from 2019-2022.

DESCRIPTIONS AND CONDITIONS:

The Long Range Plan for the Libraries had several components. The components included a survey both on line and on paper in the Libraries, four public forums, and two staff workshops. Four service responses were identified to focus on for the next four years. The responses are: Reading, Viewing and Listening for Pleasure, Lifelong Learning, Physical and Virtual Spaces, and Youth and Family Engagement. Each service response has goals, objectives and activities.

The current Long Range Plan addresses each Library individually with goals and objectives that are almost identical. The new plan addresses the Library System as a whole with common goals, objectives and service responses. This will unite the libraries as one system serving the citizens of Indian River County with excellent Libraries.

FUNDING:

No funding is required for the subject task.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff respectfully request the Board of County Commissioners approve Indian River County Library System 2019-2022 Long Range Plan.
