Subject: Public Hearing: Modification to County Code Sections 201.64 and 201.65 (Legislative)

It is requested that the Indian River County Board of County Commissioners (BCC) formally consider the following information at the BCC's regular meeting of April 7, 2020.

Background:

Section 201.64 (Definitions; construction and interpretation) under the Industrial Pretreatment Regulations Ordinance defines the terms used in the section. Section 201.65 (Prohibited discharge standards) lists pollutants, substances, or wastewater that cannot be discharged into the publicly-owned treatment works. The modifications add the prohibition of hazardous waste pharmaceuticals from healthcare facilities and reverse distributors.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends that the Indian River County Board of County Commissioners open the Public Hearing, and after hearing all public comments, approve the draft modifications to the ordinances, as proposed.
