SUBJECT: Emergency Addition: Ratification of Red Tide Clean Up Work Order #2,

Ceres Environmental Services

It has been determined that in order to effectively and expeditiously clean the coastline of Indian River County, additional vehicles, equipment, and crews are necessary. Work Order Number 2 with Ceres Environmental Services, Inc. has been executed by the County Administrator to facilitate the clean-up, and it is requested that the Board of County Commission ratify Work Order # 2.

Funding

Funding for these expenses will be provided by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection Grant on a 100% basis with no required local match.

These expenses will be accounted for in account number 11121441-033490-19005 (Transportation Fund/Road & Bridge/ Other Professional Services – Red Tide Disposal). A budget amendment will be necessary to allocate this funding.

Staff Recommendation

Staff recommends that the Board of County Commissioners ratify Work Order #2 with Ceres Environmental Services Inc.
