**PROCLAMATION DECLARING A LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY IN
INDIAN RIVER COUNTY, FLORIDA, IN CONNECTION WITH
WILDFIRES**

WHEREAS, on April 11th, 2017, Governor Rick Scott, in his capacity as Governor of the State of Florida, issued Executive Order Number 2017-120, declaring a state of emergency exists in the State of Florida due to the ongoing danger of wildfires; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 101.10(1) of the Code of Indian River County, and Resolution 2016-120 of the Board of County Commissioners, the County Administrator/Indian River County Emergency Services District Director is authorized to declare a local state of emergency upon making a determination that a natural disaster has occurred or is imminent, requiring immediate and expeditious action.

NOW, THEREFORE, in my capacity as County Administrator and Indian River County Emergency Services District Director, I hereby (1) determine that, by reason of the ongoing danger of wildfires, the threat of a natural disaster has occurred or is imminent, requiring immediate and expeditious action, and (2) declare that a local state of emergency exists in all of Indian River County, Florida, effective as of 3 p.m., on this 27th day of April, 2017.
