**SUBJECT:** Amendment No. 10 to the Civil Engineering and Land Surveying Agreement for Intersection Improvements at SR-60 and 43<sup>rd</sup> Avenue and the Widening of 43<sup>rd</sup> Avenue from 18<sup>th</sup> Street to 26<sup>th</sup> Street with Arcadis US, Inc.

**DESCRIPTION AND CONDITIONS**

Arcadis US, Inc. (fka Arcadis, G&M) is under original Agreement signed May 17, 2005 with Indian River County to provide Civil Engineering and Land Surveying Services for improvements to the SR-60/43<sup>rd</sup> Avenue Intersection and the widening of 43<sup>rd</sup> Avenue from 18<sup>th</sup> Street to 26<sup>th</sup> Street.

The purpose of Amendment No. 10 is to provide Post Design services as the Engineer of Record for this project on an “as needed” and “as requested” basis. The project construction commenced March 2020 and is expected to be completed in the second quarter of 2022.

The total negotiated not-to-exceed fee for Amendment No. 10 is \$100,000.00 to be billed based upon the attached fee schedule.

**FUNDING**

Funding is available from Optional Sales Tax/43<sup>rd</sup> Avenue & SR-60 – 18<sup>th</sup> Street to 26<sup>th</sup> Street - Account No. 31521441-066510-06041 in the amount of \$100,000.00.

**RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends approval of Amendment No. 10 to Arcadis US, Inc., authorizing the professional services as outlined in the Scope of Services and requests the Board authorize the Chairman to execute Amendment No. 10 for a not-to-exceed amount of \$100,000.00 on their behalf.
