

# *Proclamation*

## **DECLARING JULY 19-27, 2025 TREASURE COAST WATERWAY CLEANUP WEEK IN INDIAN RIVER COUNTY, FLORIDA**

*Whereas*, the Marine Industries Association of the Treasure Coast, Inc., and the Florida Inland Navigation District (FIND) are deeply concerned with keeping Treasure Coast waterways clean for all to enjoy; and

*Whereas*, the 18<sup>th</sup> Annual Treasure Coast Waterway Cleanup will be held on Saturday, July 26, 2025, from 8:00 AM to 12:30 PM; and

*Whereas*, over 1,100 volunteers, as well as numerous waterfront homeowner associations and civic groups, will participate in cleaning up our waterways out of 25 designated sites throughout Martin, St Lucie and Indian River Counties; and

*Whereas*, since these efforts began, over 100 tons of trash have been collected from approximately 125 miles of waterways along the Treasure Coast, and the sustainability of our waterways is dependent upon efforts such as this so future generations may also appreciate and enjoy them.

*Now, Therefore, be it Proclaimed by the Board of County Commissioners of Indian River County, Florida*, that the Board declares July 19 – 27, 2025 as Treasure Coast Waterway Cleanup Week in Indian River County and encourages all citizens to participate in this important event and commends the sponsors and volunteers, whose contributions to this effort are so important to its success.
