**ANALYSIS:**

The department has determined Citrus Sandblast, LLC to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. A reference check for a similar project for the City of Mount Dora provided positive feedback.

**SOURCE OF FUNDS:**

Funding in the amount of \$23,740 is budgeted and available in the Utilities Fund/General & Engineering/NCWTF Resurface Chemical Containment account 47123536-044699-19520.

**RECOMMENDATION:**
