DESCRIPTION AND CONDITIONS

On December 4, 2018, the Board of County Commissioners approved the annual agreement for Professional Geotechnical Services, with Andersen Andre Consulting Engineers, Inc. for various services including, but not limited to, field and laboratory construction materials testing in Indian River County.

The purpose of Work Order No. 3 is to provide laboratory testing and material engineering related services for the resurfacing/reclamation of 58th Avenue between 57th Street and CR 510. Andersen Andre Consulting Engineers, Inc. submitted the proposal outlined in the attached Work Order No. 3 and Scope of Services (Exhibit A) for a not-to-exceed amount of \$52,574.00,

FUNDING

As stated in the agenda item the Board of County Commissioners approved June 9, 2020, funding in the amount of \$52,574.00 will be provided by a budget amendment to Optional Sales Tax/58th Ave Resurfacing (57th Street to CR 510), Account #31521441-066510-16023. The potential to fund this project with Traffic Impact Fees will be reevaluated when the 20/21 Capital Improvements Element is formulated.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approval of Work Order No. 3 to Andersen Andre Consulting Engineers, Inc. authorizing the professional services as outlined in the Scope of Services (Exhibit A) and requests the Board to authorize the Chairman to execute Work Order No. 3 on their behalf for a not-to-exceed amount of \$52,574.00.
