PROCLAMATION

DESIGNATING MARCH OF 2021 AS AMERICAN RED CROSS MONTH

WHEREAS, the American Red Cross touches millions of lives each year as they carry out the organization's 140-year mission of preventing and alleviating suffering; and

WHEREAS, here in Indian River County, local families rely on American Red Cross volunteers for comfort and hope while coping with disasters; and

WHEREAS, Treasure Coast American Red Cross volunteers support local families in many other ways, such as providing critical safety and disaster readiness training, installing free smoke alarms, and creating fire preparedness plans; and

WHEREAS, the lifesaving work of the Red Cross is vital to strengthening our community's resilience, and nearly 200 years since the birth of founder Clara Barton, they continue to advance her noble legacy and commitment to caring for people in need.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, INDIAN RIVER COUNTY, FLORIDA that the month of March, 2021, be designated as Red Cross Month in Indian River County and that the Board encourages all citizens to support this organization, through volunteering and charitable giving, in its noble humanitarian mission to alleviate human suffering in the face of emergencies.
