Board Approval for Trade-in and Purchase Of Video Detection Processor

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**DESCRIPTION AND CONDITIONS**

In accordance with County Capital Asset Policies and Procedures, the Traffic Engineering Division seeks Board approval and authorization to trade-in one (1) traffic video detection processor and purchase one (1) processor. The processor is damaged and has minimal salvage value. The new processor is needed to maintain the County's traffic video detection system at the intersection of Bahia Mar Road and SRA1A.

The cost of the replacement processor is \$3,550.00 and the trade-in value of the damaged processor is \$710.00. The net purchase price of \$2,840.00

**FUNDING**

Funding for the purchase will come from Transportation Fund/Traffic Engineering/Traffic Signals 11124541-066440.

**RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends that the Board declare the processor surplus, approve the transaction and authorize staff to trade-in one (1) traffic video detection processor and purchase one (1) new traffic video detection processor.
