25-0907 Solid Waste Disposal District Budget (Non-Ad Valorem Special District)

A. Announce 2025/2026 Proposed Budget of \$42,047,435.

County Administrator John Titkanich announced the proposed Solid Waste Disposal District budget.

Chairman Flescher opened the public hearing. There being no speakers, the Chairman closed the hearing.

There were no proposed amendments to the budget.

Commissioner Moss stated for the record that she was opposed to Universal Collection Service from the beginning and has not changed her position.

A motion was made by Commissioner Earman, seconded by Vice Chairman Loar, to approve the Solid Waste Disposal District (SWDD) Budget of \$42,047,435 and approve Resolution 2025-054, amending the County Budget Officer's estimates of

receipts other than taxes and of balances to be brought forward for Fiscal Year 2025-2026 and adopting a final budget for the Solid Waste Disposal District. The motion carried by the following vote:

Aye: 3 - Chairman Flescher, Vice Chairman Loar, and Commissioner Earman

Nay: 1 - Commissioner Moss

Absent: 1 - Commissioner Adams

The Board of Commissioners adjourned the Solid Waste Disposal District hearing, and reconvened as the Board of County Commissioners of the Final Budget Hearing meeting, continuing with the adoption of Non-Ad Valorem Dollar Budget.
