**SUBJECT:** WeatherSTEM Phase 1 Extension of State-Funded Maintenance Costs

---

**Background:**

On November 5, 2019 Indian River County entered into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM) for the use of WeatherSTEM stations, with FDEM agreeing to be responsible for the maintenance, repair, software updates and any other costs associated with the Weather Station for three (3) years. The MOA was due to expire on June 30, 2023.

On June 28, 2023, a memorandum from FDEM was received by Indian River County Division of Emergency Management with notification that they would be extending the funding of the costs for the Weather Station for an additional three (3) years, which will now expire on June 30, 2026. All provisions of the MOA shall remain in full force and effect.
