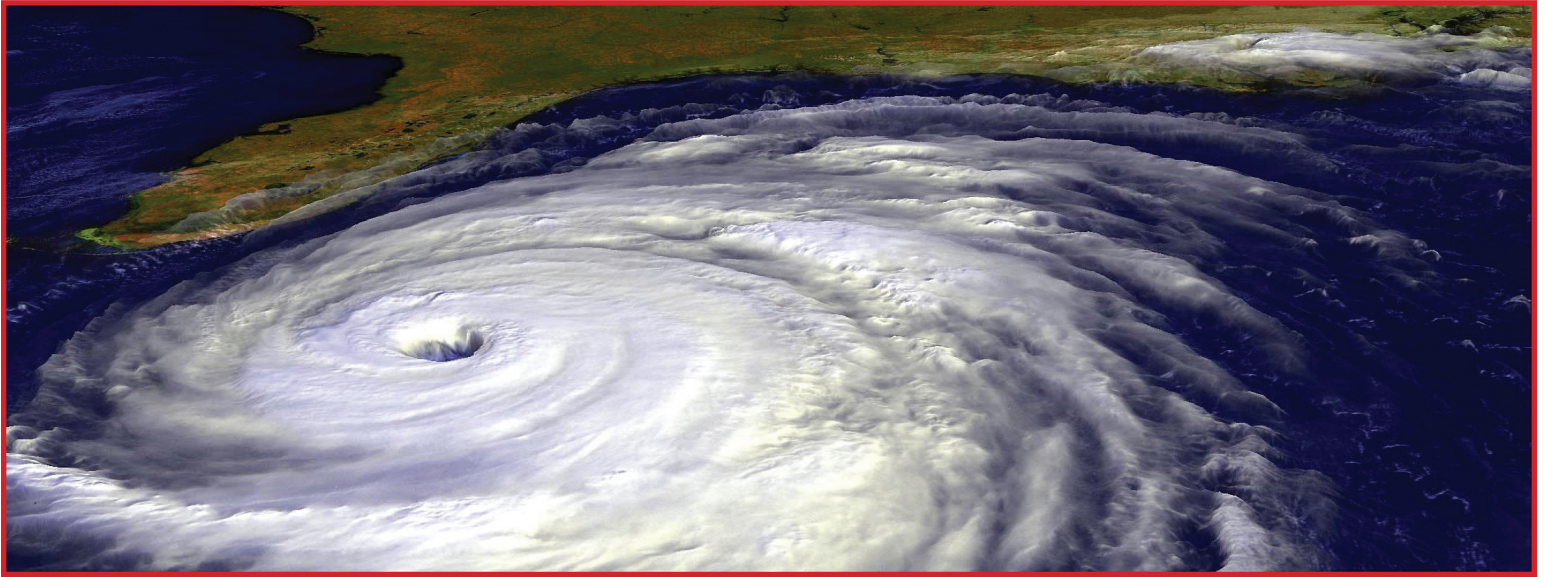

## ARE YOU READY?



### What should you do NOW?

- Trim your trees and remove debris.
- Know if you reside in an evacuation area and the location of local public shelters.
- Inventory and update your disaster supply kit. Include a 3-day supply of water (one gallon per person per day).
- Prepare to secure your home and register for a special needs shelter, if applicable.
- Be sure to include your pets in your emergency plans.

### What should you do if there is an imminent threat?

- Listen to news media or NOAA Weather Radio for critical information.
- Turn your refrigerator/freezer to the coldest setting.
- Fill your car's gas tank.
- Prepare for your pets.
- Secure your home.
- Safeguard your important documents and gather your medications.
- Evacuate if told to do so.

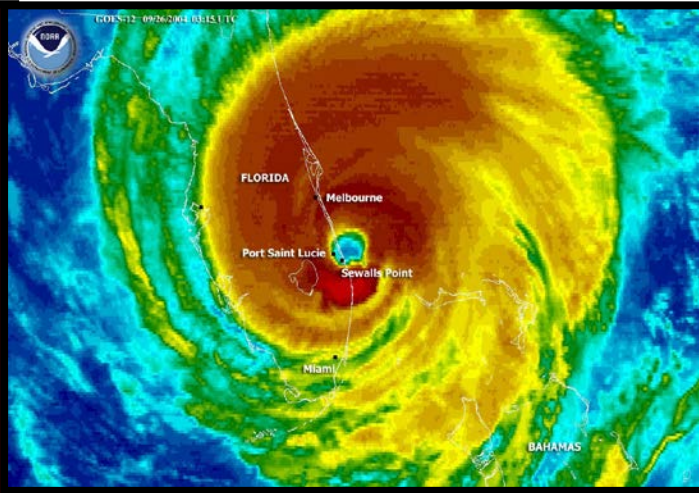
