SUBJECT: 2018 Pre-Session Legislative List of Priorities and Concerns

Background: The interim committee meetings for the 2018 State Legislative Session is scheduled to begin on September 11, 2017. This is slightly earlier than last year because the 2018 legislative session is scheduled to begin on January 9, 2017.

To date, 21 bills have been filed with the Florida Legislature. While none of the referenced bills directly impact Indian River County, the County Attorney's Office anticipates a significant number of bills to be filed in the next several months that will impact all local governments across the State of Florida.

Recommendation: The County Attorney's Office recommends that the Board adopt a 2018 pre-session legislative list of priorities and concerns.
