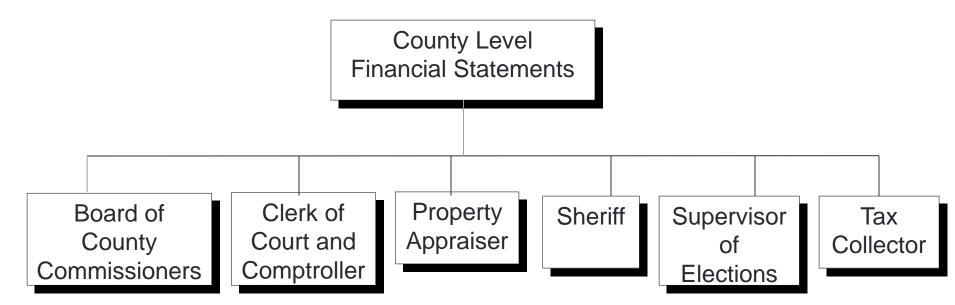

- Individual statements are included in the Auditor General section of the CAFR.

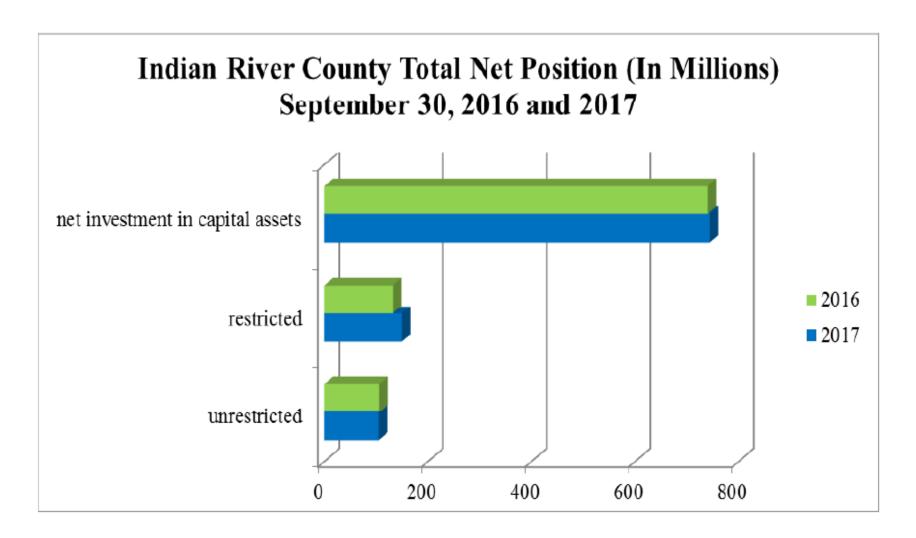

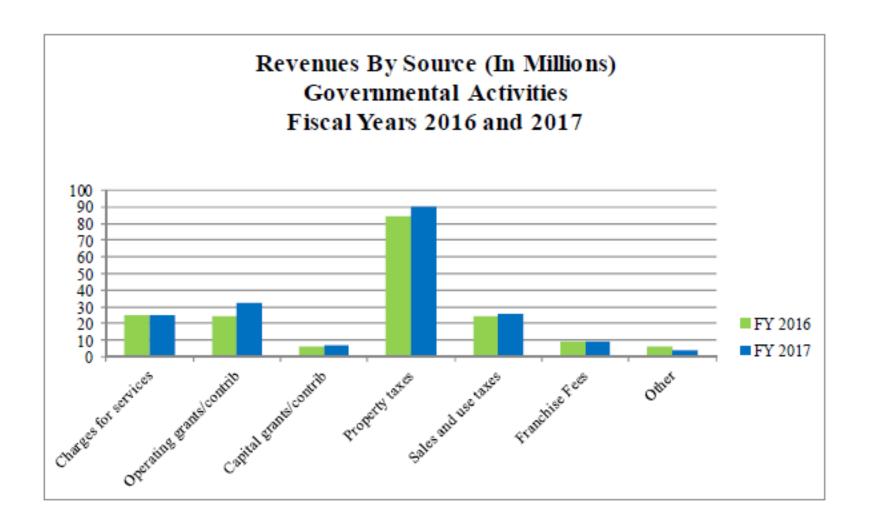

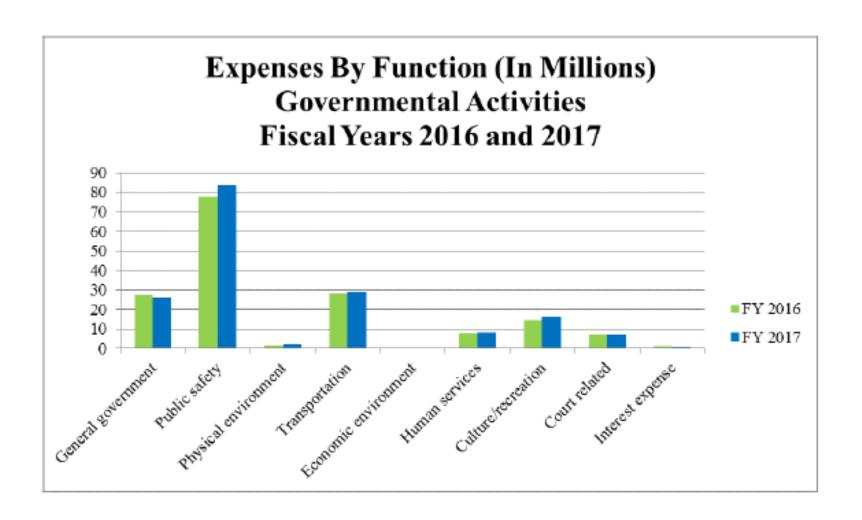

Review of Expenses



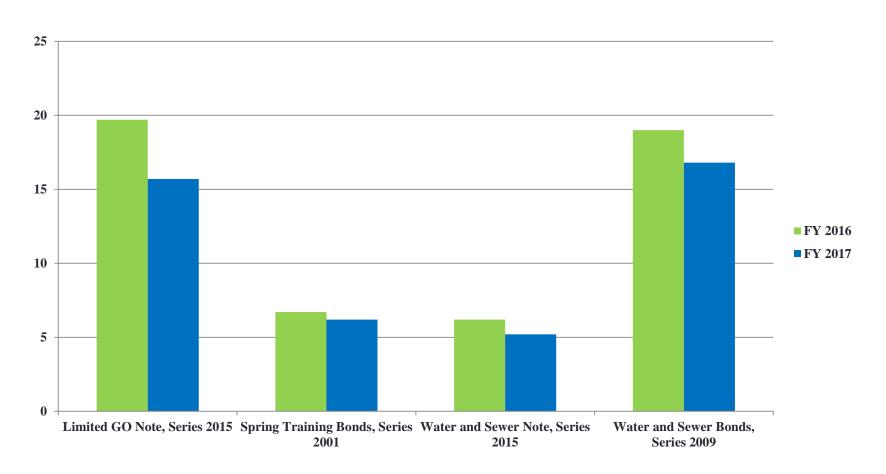

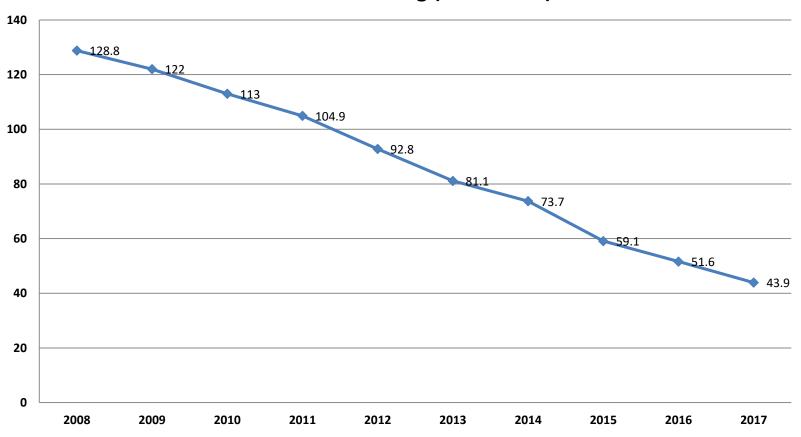
