AN ORDINANCE OF INDIAN RIVER COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE AND THE ACCOMPANYING ZONING MAP FOR APPROXIMATELY 1.50 ACRES LOCATED ON THE NORTH SIDE OF 16TH STREET, APPROXIMATELY 750 FEET EAST OF 74TH AVENUE, FROM A-1, AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT, TO RS-6, SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT; AND PROVIDING CODIFICATION, SEVERABILITY, AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

THE SOUTH 297 FEET OF THE WEST 220 FEET OF THE WEST 7.66 ACRES OF THE EAST 17.66 ACRES OF TRACT 13, SECTION 6, TOWNSHIP 33 SOUTH, RANGE 39 EAST, ACCORDING TO THE LAST GENERAL PLAT OF INDIAN RIVER FARMS COMPANY SUBDIVISION, AS RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 2, PAGE 25, OF THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF ST. LUCIE COUNTY, FLORIDA, OF WHICH INDIAN RIVER COUNTY WAS FORMERLY A PART. AND LESS THE SOUTH 30' FOR R/W (PER. BK. 1178 PG. 0472)

is changed from A-1, Agricultural District to RS-6, Residential Single-Family District.
