SUBJECT: Modification #1 to Emergency Management Federally-Funded Subgrant Agreement (**EMPG**) Agreement Number G0002

It is respectfully requested that the information contained herein be given formal consideration by the Board of County Commissioners at the next scheduled meeting.

DESCRIPTION AND CONDITIONS:

The Indian River County Board of County Commissioners executed an agreement with the Florida Division of Emergency Management on August 13, 2019 for the Emergency Management Performance Grant (**EMPG**). The EMPG grant is used to enhance and improve emergency management mitigation, planning, response and recovery directly affecting the lives and property of Indian River County residents and visitors. Due to Executive Order 20-51, dated March 1, 2020, declaring a public health emergency for the State of Florida in response to Coronavirus-19 (COVID-19), The Florida Division of Emergency Management has submitted Modification #1 to Agreement Number G0002 which extends the terms of the agreement by three (3) months with a new end date of September 30, 2020.

FUNDING:

There are no changes to the funding of the original agreement.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of Modification #1 of Federally-Funded Subgrant Agreement G0002 between Indian River County Emergency Management and the State of Florida, Division of Emergency Management.
