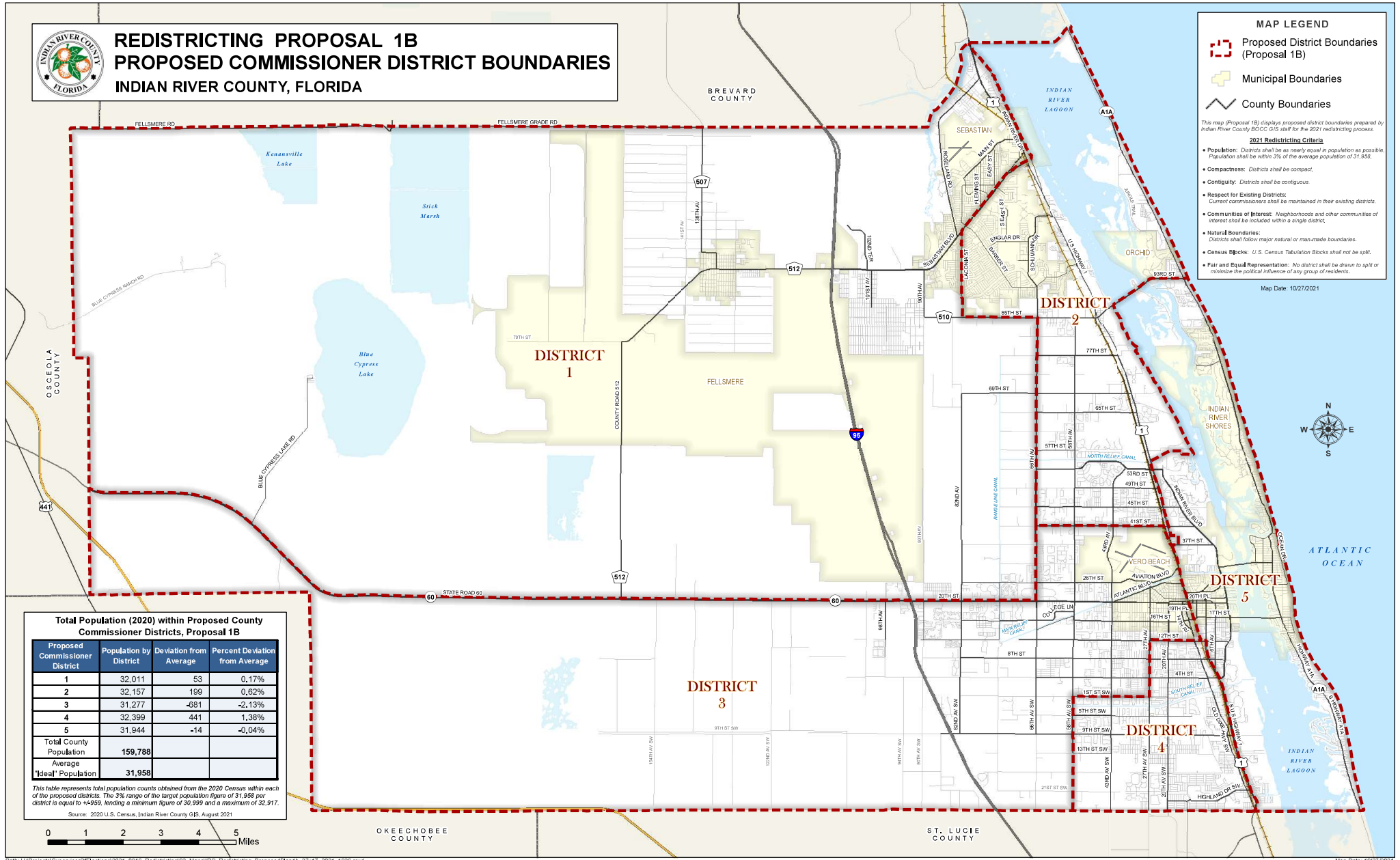

This map (Proposal 1B) displays proposed district boundaries prepared by Indian River County BOCC GIS staff for the 2021 redistricting process.

2021 Redistricting Criteria

- Population:** Districts shall be as nearly equal in population as possible. Population shall be within 3% of the average population of 31,958.
- Compactness:** Districts shall be compact.
- Contiguity:** Districts shall be contiguous.
- Respect for Existing Districts:** Current commissioners shall be maintained in their existing districts.
- Communities of Interest:** Neighborhoods and other communities of interest shall be included within a single district.
- Natural Boundaries:** Districts shall follow major natural or man-made boundaries.
- Census Blocks:** U.S. Census Tabulation Blocks shall not be split.
- Fair and Equal Representation:** No district shall be drawn to split or minimize the political influence of any group of residents.

This table represents total population counts obtained from the 2020 Census within each of the proposed districts. The 3% range of the target population figure of 31,958 per district is equal to +4,959, leaving a minimum figure of 30,999 and a maximum of 32,917.
