SUBJECT: Approval of Agreement for 911 Recording System Maintenance

BACKGROUND:

The Emergency Services District operates the County-wide 911 call taking network and systems, located at the Indian River County Sheriff's Office, City of Sebastian, City of Vero Beach and at the Emergency Operations Center (EOC). A vital component of this system is the recording of the calls.

DISCUSSION:

The term of the current maintenance program expired on March 1, 2025. Staff would like to enter into a maintenance agreement for the recording system software maintenance with Quality Recording Solutions, LLC. The annual cost of this platform is \$27,350, which will continue annually for five (5) years. The total cost over the life of this agreement is \$136,750.

FUNDING:

Funding for the first year, in the amount of \$27,350, will be made available in the 911 Surcharge/Communications Center/Other Contractual Services account, number 12013325-033490, via budget amendment.
