BACKGROUND

In 2005, Indian River County Board of County Commissioners entered into a lease agreement with MetroPCS California/Florida, Inc. (now known as MetroPCS Florida, Inc a Delaware limited liability company and owned by T-Mobile). The Agreement allowed MetroPCS to install and operate a communications facility at Kings Highway Elevated Water Tank. MetroPCS desires to enter into a First Amendment of this agreement.

FUNDING

There is no cost to the county as a result of this lease. However, the county will receive revenue as a result of this lease agreement. The revenue will be recorded in the operating fund under the Radio Tower Rents Account at a monthly license fee of Four Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$4,950.00) per month, subject to a 4% annual increase.
