Said Library is to be completed no later than April 5, 1995. Any menies realized from sale of said quit-claimed property must be used for books and internal requirements for the main County Library and shall not be used for bricks and mortar or for the reduction of the amount of the bond issue. Should GRANTEE fall to fulfill the requirements of this condition subsequent, the GRANTEE shall immediately reconvey said property by a quit-claim deed to the City of Vero Beach. Reconveyance to the City may be enforced by a Writ of Mandamus.
