SUBJECT: Resolution Authorizing the Submittal of an Application to FDEP Requesting an Easement for Utilities on State Owned Uplands under Lease by Indian River County

With regard to temporary Fire Station #15 at the North County Regional Park, the County, as the utility service provider, will require a utility easement for the water line servicing the modular structure. Since Indian River County manages the property under Lease Agreement No. 4490 and Sublease No. 4490-1, with the Board of Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund, an Application for the Use of State Owned Uplands is required to be submitted; and a formal resolution of the Board of County Commissioners requesting such an easement must accompany the application.

Presented herewith for consideration and adoption is a resolution authorizing the submittal of an application to FDEP requesting a utility easement for the water line.

**FUNDING:**

There is no cost associated with the application.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Adopt the resolution, and authorize the Chairman to execute same for submitting with the application request to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection.
