WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation provides Transit Corridor Grant funds to Indian River County to assist in the continuance and expansion of local public transportation services.

- 1. That the Chairman of the Indian River County Board of County Commissioners is authorized to execute a public transportation Supplemental Joint Participation Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation to obtain \$99,750 in FY 2017/18 state Transit Corridor Grant funds for operating assistance as part of the County's ongoing public transportation service.
- 2. That the Indian River County Community Development Director is authorized to furnish such additional information as the Florida Department of Transportation may require in connection with the County's Transit Corridor Grant.
