A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF INDIAN RIVER COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN'S EXECUTION OF A SUBORDINATION OF CITY UTILITY INTERESTS FOR THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE 43<sup>RD</sup> AVENUE/STATE ROAD 60 PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the construction improvements to the 43<sup>rd</sup> Avenue/State Road 60 intersection, including the addition of turn lanes, drainage piping with drainage structures, signalization, signing and pavement markings from 18<sup>th</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> Street ("Project") is an Indian River County priority project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Vero Beach has two utility easements that may be affected by the Project; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida, Department of Transportation, has requested Indian River County execute and deliver to the State of Florida, Department of Transportation, a Subordination of City Utility Interests for the aforementioned Project, in case the utility facilities need to be relocated should there be a conflict that arises during construction of the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF INDIAN RIVER COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the Chairman of the Board is hereby authorized to make, execute, and deliver to the State of Florida, Department of Transportation, a Subordination of City Utility Interests for the aforementioned project.
