SUBJECT: Request of Name Change from Cleveland Clinic Martin Health for
Current Class B Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity

It is respectfully requested that the information contained herein be given formal consideration by the Board of County Commissioners at the next scheduled meeting.

Background:

On October 1, 2019, the Board approved a Class B Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide Non-Emergency ambulance inter-facility medical transports at the ALS/BLS level for Cleveland Clinic Martin Health. On January 16, 2020 an application was submitted for a name change from Cleveland Clinic Martin Health to Cleveland Clinic Advanced Medical Transport. All other information and requirements that were provided during the initial application process remained the same.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends the Board of County Commissioners approve the name change and issue a new Class "B" COPCN certificate to Cleveland Clinic Advanced Medical Transport.
