

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-

A RESOLUTION OF INDIAN RIVER COUNTY, FLORIDA, ESTABLISHING THE TAX MILLAGE RATE TO BE LEVIED UPON ALL REAL AND PERSONAL TAXABLE PROPERTY IN INDIAN RIVER COUNTY, FLORIDA, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026 FOR THE INDIAN RIVER COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the Budget Officer of Indian River County prepared and presented to the County Commission a tentative budget for the Emergency Services District of Indian River County, Florida, for the fiscal year commencing on the first day of October, 2025, and ending on the 30th day of September, 2026, addressing each of the funds therein as provided by law, including all estimated receipts, taxes to be levied, and balances expected to be brought forward, and all estimated expenditures, reserves, and balances to be carried over at the end of the year; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Indian River County held a public workshop to consider and amend the tentative budget as presented; and

WHEREAS, the Board did prepare a statement summarizing all of the tentative budgets showing for each budget and for the total of all budgets, proposed tax millages, the balances and reserves, and the total of each major classification of the receipts and expenditures classified according to accounts prescribed by the appropriate state agencies; and

WHEREAS, the proposed millage rate for the Emergency Services District is above the rolled back rate of 2.2147 by 6.25%; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Indian River County did hold a public hearing to review and adopt a tentative budget; and

WHEREAS, the final budget hearing has been properly advertised and held in accordance with applicable Florida law,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF INDIAN RIVER COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board, on behalf of the Indian River County Emergency Services District, does herewith levy upon all real and personal taxable property in Indian River County, Florida, within the district, for fiscal year 2025-2026, a tax of 2.3531 mills on the dollar for the purpose of funding the Emergency Services District of Indian River County;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the millage as adopted herein shall be filed in the Office of the County Budget Officer and in the Public Records; and the County Budget Officer shall transmit forthwith a certified copy of this resolution to the Property Appraiser for Indian River County, to the Tax Collector for Indian River County, and to the Department of Revenue of the State of Florida.

A RESOLUTION OF INDIAN RIVER COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE COUNTY BUDGET OFFICER'S ESTIMATES OF RECEIPTS OTHER THAN TAXES AND OF BALANCES TO BE BROUGHT FORWARD FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026 AND ADOPTING A FINAL BUDGET FOR THE EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the Budget Officer of Indian River County has ascertained the needs and the fiscal policy of the Board of County Commissioners for the ensuing fiscal year and did prepare and present to the Board a tentative budget for fiscal year 2025-2026, including all estimates of receipts, taxes to be levied, and balances expected to be brought forward and all estimated expenditures, reserves, and balances to be carried over at the end of the year; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Indian River County did examine the tentative budget and held public hearings, pursuant to law, to consider input from the citizens of Indian River County with respect to taxes to be levied and the amounts and the use of money derived from the levy of taxes,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF INDIAN RIVER COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

1. The County Budget Officer's estimates of receipts other than taxes and of balances to be brought forward for the Emergency Services District are hereby revised as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto.
2. The Board of County Commissioners of Indian River County, on behalf of the Indian River County Emergency Services District, hereby adopts the budget as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto, as the final budget for fiscal year 2025-2026 for the Emergency Services District.
