## **IMPACT 100 DAY**

**WHEREAS**, November is National Philanthropy Month, an observance designated by the Association of Fundraising Professionals, and is a month to celebrate the importance of supporting our local nonprofit organizations for the common good; and

**WHEREAS,** Impact 100 of Indian River County, Inc. is comprised of women who collectively impact the lives of individuals and our community through transformational giving by offering them an opportunity to participate in high impact grant making by pooling resources and are able to provide \$100,000 grants to local nonprofits each year; and

WHEREAS, In July 2019, Impact 100 of Indian River County, Inc. achieved a significant milestone by becoming its own independent 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization and ceased being a fund of the Indian River Community Foundation; and

**WHEREAS,** In the past twelve (12) years and through the power of team philanthropy, Impact 100 of Indian River County, Inc. has awarded more than \$4.6 million to 49 local area nonprofits to transform the lives of the residents of Indian River County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF INDIAN RIVER COUNTY, FLORIDA that the Board recognizes November 10, 2020 as "IMPACT 100 DAY" and hereby congratulates Impact 100 of Indian River County, Inc. on their support of nonprofit organizations through high impact grants.
