

PROCLAMATION

RECOGNIZING THE MONTH OF OCTOBER, 2021, AS NATIONAL DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AWARENESS MONTH

WHEREAS, each day in America, four women are murdered by their intimate partners; and

WHEREAS, each day in America, an average of twenty people every minute are abused by their intimate partners; and

WHEREAS, one-in-three American women and one-in-four men have experienced some form of intimate partner violence; and

WHEREAS, National Domestic Violence Awareness Month provides all Americans the opportunity to recommit to ensuring that every relationship be violence-free; and

WHEREAS, in Indian River County, SafeSpace, Incorporated, joins forces with law enforcement, victim service programs, criminal justice officials, social service organizations, and concerned citizens to fight domestic violence and provide all domestic violence victims a safe place where they can live with respect, resources, restoration, and justice; together, their commitment and compassion help to ensure that our community steps forward to support domestic violence victims in need.
