**Discussion Item:**

Our having had the benefit of the Indian River Soil & Water Conservation District meeting on 04/12/2021, let us discuss updating our County's geohydrology study. Kindly refer to Indian River County 2030 Comprehensive Plan (adopted 10/12/2010) Chapter 3D, Natural Groundwater Aquifer Recharge Sub-Element, Objective 2, Preserving the Quantity of the Surficial Aquifer, Policy 2.6: "By 2011, the county shall contact the U.S. Geological Survey and request an updated county-wide geohydrologic survey". Staff has supplied the most recent document in this regard, "Geohydrology of Indian River County, Florida", dated 1988.
