**SUBJECT:** Request to Purchase an ALS Fire Engine for Fire-Rescue Station 14

It is respectfully requested that the information contained herein be given formal consideration by the District Board of Commissioners at the next scheduled meeting.

**DESCRIPTION AND CONDITIONS:**

Staff is seeking authorization to purchase an ALS fire engine for Fire-Rescue Station 14 (6780 26<sup>th</sup> Street), which is scheduled to open for service in October 2017. This is a planned expenditure and is detailed in the County’s Fiscal Year 2017/18 Capital Improvement Element (CIE) the Board adopted on December 6, 2016. The Board will recall there is a protracted delivery time of approximately ten months for this specialized equipment, and payment will not be due until final acceptance.

The fire engine will be purchased through a statewide bid contract; and, ordering now locks in the current price, as there is an announced price increase for orders received after February 2017. The funding for this purchase is from Emergency Services District funds.

This is a planned expenditure and detailed in the County Capital Improvement Element.
