The Board reconvened as the Board of Commissioners of the Solid Waste Disposal District.

The 2017-2018 proposed charges for the Solid Waste Disposal District were outlined by Administrator Brown as follows:

\$68.19 per Residential Waste Generation Unit (\$109.10/House) (6.3% increase from current year)

\$37.67 per Commercial Waste Generation Unit (6.0% increase from current year)

Readiness-to-Use Fee \$21.59 (5.4% increase from current year)

Administrator Brown disclosed that the proposed budget for 2017-2018 is \$14,048,177, a decrease of \$305,000 or 2.1% from the current year budget.

The Chairman opened the floor for public comments; there were no speakers and the Chairman closed the public comment session.

A motion was made by Vice Chairman O'Bryan, seconded by Commissioner Adams, to adopt the Non-Ad Valorem assessment rates of \$68.19 per Residential Waste Generation Unit; \$37.67 per Commercial Waste Generation Unit; and \$21.59 Readiness-to-use fee for the Solid Waste Disposal District. The motion carried by the following vote:
