SUBJECT: Resolution Cancelling Taxes on Property Purchased from Central Groves Corp. for 66th Avenue Widening Project

A parcel consisting of 18.59 acres has been purchased by Indian River County from Central Groves Corp. for right-of-way and a stormwater retention pond in connection with the 66th Avenue road widening project; and a resolution is presented for the purpose of earmarking the public use of the property and cancelling any delinquent or current taxes which may exist on the property.

FUNDING:

There is no cost associated with this item.

RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners to execute the Resolution to cancel certain taxes upon the property purchased for right-of-way and a stormwater retention pond, and the Clerk to send a certified copy of the Resolution to the Tax Collector and the Property Appraiser so that any delinquent or current taxes can be cancelled.
