SUBJECT: Resolution Supporting School Board Referendum For 0.5 Mill for School Operational

Purposes

BACKGROUND.

The School Board of Indian River County passed Resolution 2020-09 on April 28, 2020, directing the Indian River County Board of County Commissioners to call an election, at which the electors within the School District may vote on the approval of an additional ad valorem millage of 0.50 mill for school operational purposes for the 2021/2022, 2022/2023, 2023/2024 and 2024/2025 fiscal years.

At the May 12, 2020 Indian River County Board of County Commissioners (the "Board') meeting, the Board voted to direct the County Attorney's Office to draft a resolution in support of the proposed millage for school operational purposes, which will provide high-quality educational opportunities for all students, help recruit and retain high-quality educators, create technology-enhanced classrooms, and expand support for school safety and mental health. Per the Board's direction the County Attorney's Office has drafted the attached resolution.

FUNDING.

There is no funding associated with this item.

RECOMMENDATION.

The County Attorney's Office recommends that the Board approve the resolution as presented or as amended.
