

**EXTENSION TO INDIAN RIVER COUNTY
CARES ACT AGREEMENT**

THIS EXTENSION TO INDIAN RIVER COUNTY CARES ACT AGREEMENT (“Extension”) is entered into as of the ____ day of January, 2021 by and between Indian River County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, whose address is 1801 27th Street, Vero Beach, Florida, 32960 (“Recipient”), and the City of Vero Beach, a municipality, whose address is 1053 20th Place, Vero Beach, Florida 32960 (the “Subrecipient”).

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Recipient and Subrecipient entered into the Indian River County CARES Act Agreement, which set forth a scope of work for the use of CARES Act funds by the Subrecipient (the “Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, the Agreement was to expire on December 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Recipient and Subrecipient wish to extend the Agreement until September 30, 2021; and

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual undertakings herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties agree, as follows:

1. **Recitals**. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein.
2. **Extension of the Agreement**. The Agreement is extended until September 30, 2021.
3. All other provisions of the Agreement, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
