**Subject:** Federal Transit Administration FY 2023 Triennial Review Final Report

It is requested that the information presented herein be given formal consideration by the Board of County Commissioners at its regular meeting of November 7, 2023.

**SUMMARY**

The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) provides funding assistance for capital and operating costs associated with Indian River County's public transportation system. The GoLine (fixed route) and the Community Coach (demand response) transit services are operated by the Senior Resource Association (SRA). Overall, FTA funding programs cover nearly all of the capital expenses and approximately half of the operating costs associated with GoLine and Community Coach.

Every three years, FTA conducts a thorough review of the County's public transportation system. This is known as a Triennial Review. Recently, FTA completed its FY 2023 Triennial Review and issued a final report with no deficiencies found. This marks the first time that Indian River County has completed an FTA Triennial Review with no findings.
