BACKGROUND

Indian River County is in the last year of our Microsoft Enterprise Agreement. The agreement is to be renewed in December 2024 for another three years. This agreement covers software we purchase including backend software (Windows Server, Exchange Email Server, SQL Server) and our Cloud Office Suite (Microsoft 365). The Department of Information Technology got a quote from each License Service Provider: SHI is quoted at \$555,077.65; Insight Public Sector is quoted at \$476,654.87 annually, under a cooperative agreement awarded by NASPO; CDW is quoted at \$547,204.66.

Funding for the software is available in the Informational Technology Fund/Information Systems/Computer Software Account 50524113-035120 and the Main Library Account 00110971-035120.
