

Comparison of Florida Statute AHAC Membership Requirements to Current County AHAC Membership

Florida Statutes 420.9076 Adoption of affordable housing incentive strategies; committees.

(1) Each county or eligible municipality participating in the State Housing Initiatives Partnership Program, including a municipality receiving program funds through the county, or an eligible municipality must, within 12 months after the original adoption of the local housing assistance plan, amend the plan to include local housing incentive strategies as defined in s. 420.9071(16).

(2) The governing board of a county or municipality shall appoint the members of the affordable housing advisory committee. Pursuant to the terms of any interlocal agreement, a county and municipality may create and jointly appoint an advisory committee. The local action adopted pursuant to s. 420.9072 which creates the advisory committee and appoints the advisory committee members **must name at least 8 but not more than 11 committee members** and specify their terms. The committee must consist of **one representative from at least six of the (staff note: first 11 listed) categories below:**
