AN ORDINANCE OF INDIAN RIVER COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE AND THE ACCOMPANYING ZONING MAP FOR APPROXIMATELY 1.04 ACRES LOCATED ON THE NORTH SIDE OF COUNTY ROAD 510, APPROXIMATELY 500 FEET NORTHEAST OF U.S. HIGHWAY 1, FROM CL, LIMITED COMMERICAL DISTRICT, TO CG, GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT; AND PROVIDING CODIFICATION, SEVERABILITY, AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

ALL OF LOTS 1, 2, 3, AND 10, TOGETHER WITH THE PORTIONS OF LOTS 4, 5, 7, 8, 9, 12 AND 13 LYING NORTHERLY OF THE RIGHT OF WAY FOR COUNTY ROAD 510, ALL IN BLOCK 9, WEONA PARK SUBDIVISION REPLAT, AS RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 2, PAGE 17 OF THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF INDIAN RIVER COUNTY, FLORIDA.

is changed from CL, Limited Commercial District to CG, General Commercial District.

All with the meaning and intent and as set forth and described in said Land Development Regulations.

This ordinance shall become effective upon filing with the Department of State.
